WHITE WINE

- 1. Pinot Grigio Primi Soli (2)** **£25.00**
Italy 175ml Glass £6.45
250ml Glass £8.45
Dry, crisp and fruity with a wonderful hint of lemon. Easy drinking in style.
- 2. Central Monte Chardonnay (2)** **£27.00**
Chile 175ml Glass £6.95
250ml Glass £9.15
Wonderful aromas of citrus fruit and peach that transfer to a mouth-watering apple and honey.
- 3. Long White Cloud Sauvignon Blanc (1)** **£29.00**
New Zealand 175ml Glass £8.05
250ml Glass £10.15
Our deliciously crisp and fresh Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc from New Zealand shows wonderful green citrus notes alongside ripe stone-fruit flavours.
- 4. Picpoul De Pinet Foncastel (1)** **£31.00**
France

France
The nose will reveal aromas of white flowers, elderflower, acacia and citrus notes. The palate is tight and invigorating with a mineral finish.

- 6. Pinot Grigio Rosé Primi Soli (2)** **£25.00**
Italy 175ml Glass £6.45

A very easy style of wine with a soft, refreshing burst of summer red fruits.
- 7. Painted Ladies White Zinfandel (2)** **£25.00**

Medium bodied with juicy flavours of raspberry, cherry and subtle tropical fruit aromas.

RED WINE

- 8. Central Monte Merlot (B)** **£25.00**
Chile 175ml Glass £6.45

A beautiful bouquet of black cherries and red summer fruits. Soft tannins on the palate make for a very smooth and balanced wine.
- 9. Down Under Shiraz (C)** **£27.00**

Lovely plum aromas with a hint of pepper and spice. Complimented by a luscious berry palate.
- 10. Equino Malbec (D)** **£29.00**
Argentina 175ml Glass £8.05

A mix of plum, raspberry and blackberry, medium-bodied, yet soft and silky with seductive tannins. The purity of this wine is a natural acidity which complements the fruits in a great, lengthy finish. SWA Bronze Award.
- 11. Faustino Rivero Crianza D.O.Ca Rioja (C)** **£37.00**
Spain
This wine has matured in American oak casks for 12-14 months and has spicy aromas on the palate.
- 12. Valpolicella Classico DOC Monteci (C)** **£39.00**
Italy
Fresh berry fruit flavours with hints of cherry, well balanced with a rich long lasting finish.

- 13. I Castelli Prosecco DOC (1)** **£30.00**
Italy
A lovely straw yellow with a faint greenish reflection in colour. The aroma is subtle with a fruity scent and hints of apple.
- 14. Prosecco Serenello Extra Dry (1)** 20cl Bottle **£8.50**
Italy
Delicious aromas of apple and pear melt into a fresh wine.
- 15. Moët & Chandon Brut NV (1)** **£67.50**
France
Still the best selling Non-Vintage Champagne in the UK, this classic blend boasts notes of green apple & citrus fruits.

Champagne, White and Rosé wines are designated numbers from 1 to 9, with 1 being the driest and 9 being the sweetest. Red wines are designated letters from A to E, with A being the lightest and softest and E being the deepest and fullest.
